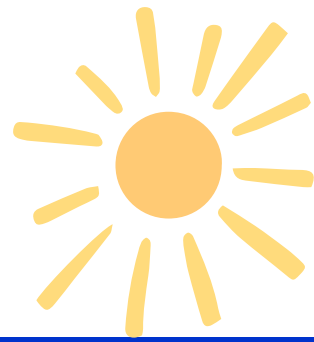

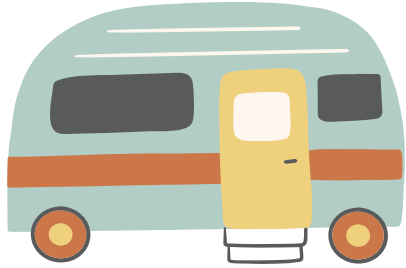

As your Loyal Knight, I am tasked to "See that each member is rewarded as they shall deserve". This is a nearly impossible task with so many people doing so many things!

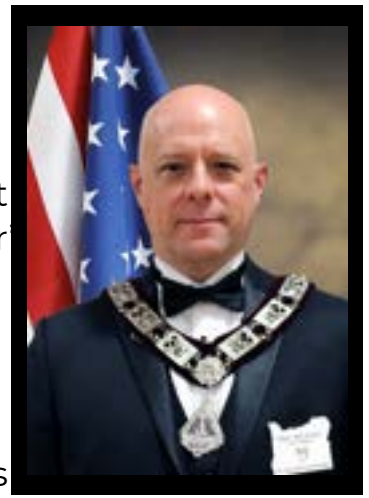

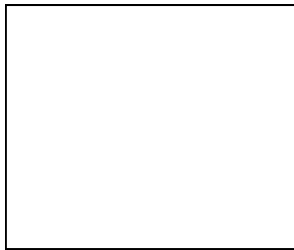
