- **Supplies & Tools:** A list of needed tools and supplies for repairs and cleaning will be shared in the next few months.

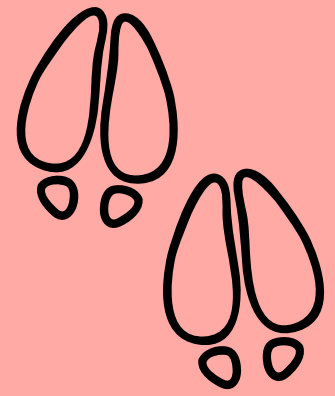
This event is a great opportunity to connect with members from other Lodges while giving back. More updates will be provided soon, but be sure to mark your calendars now!

The first meeting on February 6th, any member in good standing can nominate any other member, also in good standing, to one of the elected officer positions. Our lodge is at its best when its members are active and engaged. Maybe you've thought about being an officer, or maybe you know someone who you think would be a great asset to our lodge as an officer. This is your chance. Bring your nomination down to the lodge on February 6th and become a part of the election process.

You never know—you could be nominating someone, or, for that matter, someone could be nominating you to be the Exalted Ruler someday! Come on down and be an integral part of the process.

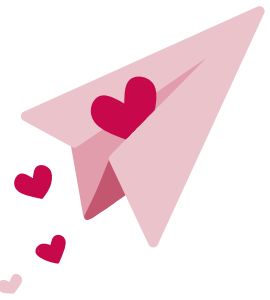

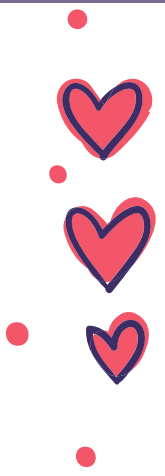
## **VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH: JOE BALDWIN**

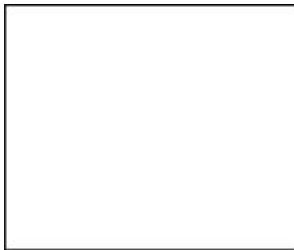
