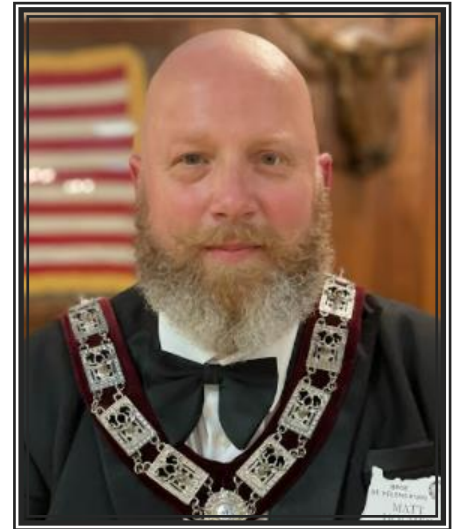

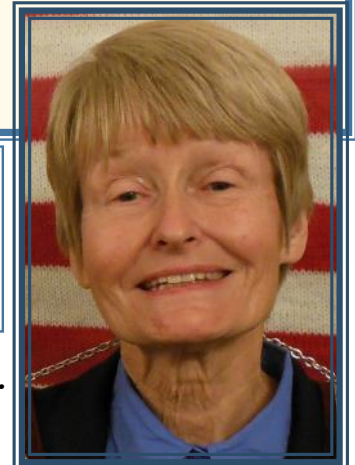

It's all about the dues! Grand Lodge should have mailed them to you by now. If not, I'm hoping a dues sheet for 23/24 is included in this bulletin, and it will

be online and available for those with email addresses. First of all...

1. PLEASE DO NOT DISCARD YOUR CURRENT MEMBER CARD UNTIL APRIL 30.... We always give delinquent members 2 or 3 weeks after April 1 to renew membership...before we change the lock on the lodge door to accommodate the member cards (hunter orange) for the 2023-24 member year. I do NOT want to hand out more green member cards to people who threw theirs away too soon! The orange cards for the coming year won't work till the door lock is changed.
2. Dues are \$83.15 for Life Members and \$138.15 for the rest of us. Please send in the full amount of dues along with the full sheet from Grand Lodge or with our lodge's dues sheet. Big Data does not accept "down payments." If you send in less than the full dues amount, your check will be sent back to you.
3. How to pay. It is best if you mail your check and dues sheet to the lodge, or if you pay online via Grand lodge.
4. Very important: **PLEASE DO NOT PAY YOUR DUES AT THE BAR!** These ladies are

already very, very busy serving food and drink to club members, and they should not be asked to process member dues. I will be processing hundreds of dues, and the ones taken at the bar can take days or weeks to get to the secretary's office. Dues sheets will be available at the bar for you to fill out, attach your payment, and deposit through the mail slot on the secretary's office door!

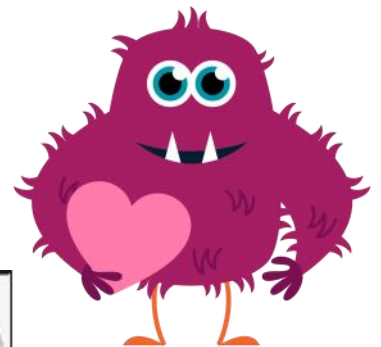
