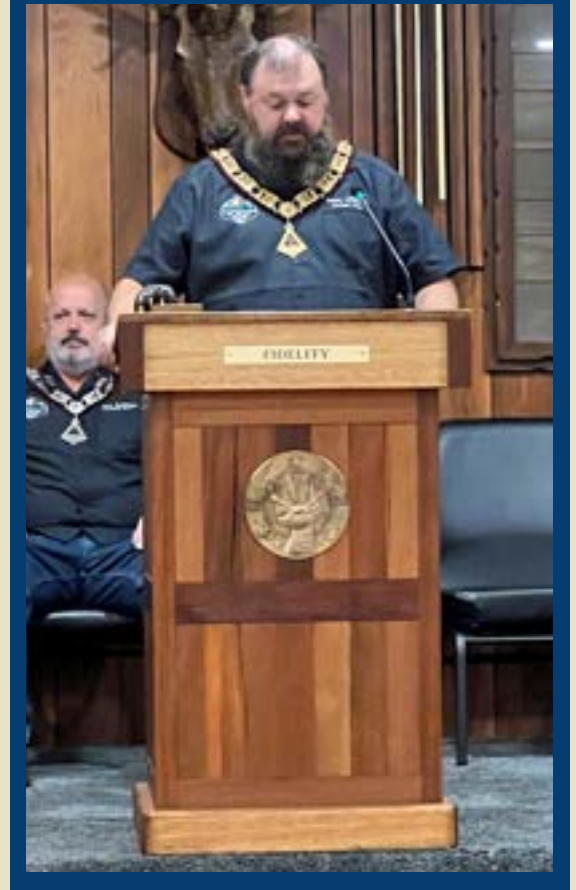


# Father's Day Celebration Flights & Bites

My opinion, we are second to none, and dare I say, other Lodges aspire to be more like St. Helens Lodge #1999. We all should be proud.

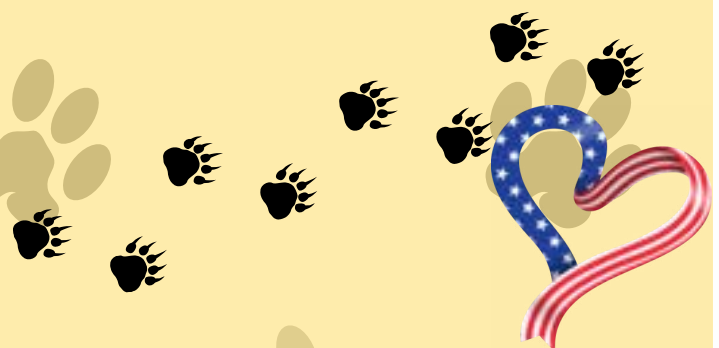

We have been printing bulletins and putting over 240 bulletins into the mail each month. This is expensive and it requires significant volunteer time to prep and mail them.

As a result, we have reduced the size of the mailed bulletin so that it can be sent by first class mail with only one stamp. It will still contain all critical updates. 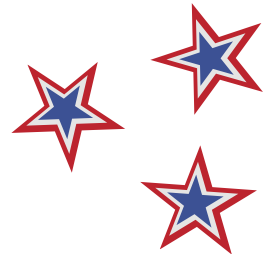

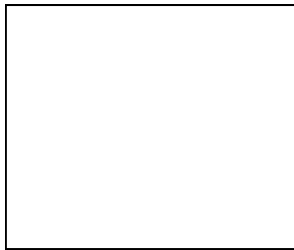
