GIVING TIME OF YEAR

This month you will be seeing a Christmas tree in the foyer, a Necessities Box, Food Barrel and Gift Wrap Box. **DEADLINE IS DECEMBER 18th!**

GIVING CHRISTMAS TREE—The Elks sponsor families every year. We ask the families to make a list of items they are in need of and we place tags on the tree. You take the tag, buy the item and wrap the item. Tape the tag on the item (so we know what it is) and place it under the tree!

NECESSITIES BOX—These are normal everyday items that people need & use. When you're low on money, these items are last on the list after food and bills. You might not think it's glamorous to buy things like toilet paper, garbage bags, toiletries, etc...those items are a blessing if you don't have them.

FOOD BARREL—We will be collecting dry goods (canned and boxed food) items that are not time sensitive and can be left on a shelf. Some of the families we sponsor are food deprived. We also make up food baskets for 20-25 families every year to help them with this.

WRAPPING PAPER—It's simple—some people forget to wrap the present under the tree. Some families need the paper to wrap the few gifts they have. The Elks also sponsors up to 100 children every year and purchase multiple presents for each one. This equals *LOTS* of wrapping paper!
